

**Subject:** CALCTP-AT Technician Acceptance Testing Course

**Goal:** Effective July 1, 2014, the California Energy Commission adopted changes to the California building Efficiency Standards (Title 24, Parts 1 and 6) that require lighting controls and devices to be certified as properly installed and operational, prior to issuance of occupancy permits. The California Advanced Lighting Controls Training Program-Acceptance Technician (CALCTP-AT) certifies acceptance technicians.

Candidates interested in applying as a CALCTP-AT Technician must submit an application which is available at [www.calctp.org/acceptance-technicians](http://www.calctp.org/acceptance-technicians) and pay an application fee as required.
